

Hello everyone,

We have posted a sign-up sheet outside the class door for all the great volunteer opportunities that await you this year! We realize many of you may not make it all the way upstairs for drop off, so the positions are listed below, along with a description. Please take a moment to review and see if there is something you may be able to help our class out with this year, the kids love it when their parents get involved!

Art A la Carte - Send communications to parents encouraging them to teach these once-monthly pre-planned lessons.

Square One Art - One or two parents needed from each classroom needed to come into the classroom and help students create a specific piece of artwork (ex: Kindergartens could draw and color a sky and sun scene). The art must be done in the month of **September**. It will take one or two 1-hour sessions in the classroom to finish. Instructions and all supplies will be provided.

Class Directory – Take pictures of students and merge with directory information to create a photo directory of class.

Class Party - There are typically 2 per year. Consult with the classroom teacher before scheduling and then send out email requests to parents if needed.

Red Folders – (Weekly Classroom Communications Coordinator) A volunteer is needed EACH Tuesday morning. It is ideal if one person can take on this commitment.

Library Volunteer - Visit the library with the class once every other week for about 45 minutes. Check in class books, shelve books and check out new books.

Teacher Lunches– this volunteer signs up parents to bring in a meal to our hard working teachers once a month. Have the teacher fill out an *All About Me* form (can be found on the PTO website) that tells what kind of foods they like. Please use SignUp Genius to coordinate monthly volunteers. This person can also be the coordinator for Teacher Appreciation Week, if so decided.

Class Photographer / Yearbook – Take photos of special events, help yearbook staff with class page. Information on what pictures are needed as well as uploading instructions can be given by Room Parent or Yearbook chairperson.

Spooky Spectacular Carnival – These 2 volunteers help coordinate class parent volunteers at Spooky Spectacular, a fun, family-oriented carnival for the whole school. Parent volunteers are needed to staff the booth during the event. Specific instructions will be given out prior to the event and are easy to follow.

Huckleberry Bash – This event is our big adult school fundraiser. This volunteer will be responsible for obtaining one donation to be auctioned off at the event.

Field Day / Class T-Shirt – This fun filled athletic competition occurs in December. Together with the teacher, design and order class t-shirts. Most teachers like to use this same t-shirt for field trips throughout the year, so this volunteer would need to get together with their teacher soon. Schedule parents to assist during the day and provide refreshments.
